# Tolerance Tips

- © **Eat!** Have a mixed culture lunch. Invite co-workers to bring dishes that reflect their culture, and share and share alike
- © Get your company to **sponsor** an outreach programme
- ② Look at the **degree of diversity** in your workplace. Are there barriers that make it harder for certain groups to succeed? Try to remove them.
- if you do the **recruiting**, cast a wide net, and give everyone a chance. Post all job openings internally first
- Try to value the input of everyone you work with
- ② Avoid **singling out employees** of a certain race or ethinicity to "deal with" issues of diversity on behalf of everyone else
- ② Do lunch! Vary your lunch partners. Choose co-workers with different backgrounds to yours, from different parts of the company and at various job levels

- © **Start a mentoring programme**. Use the programme to team up veteran employees with newcomers
- © Establish **internal procedures** for employees to be able to report harassment and discrimination incidents. Make sure the whole company knows about it
- Try to develop an "open-door" policy



- © Fight against the "just like me" bias, which is the tendency to favour those who are similar to ourselves
- If your company donates to certain charities or organisations, or does voluntary work for them, publicise this fact widely and, when given the opportunity, challenge other companies to match or exceed the efforts your company makes
